In addition to the specific activities proposed for funding during program year 2022, other actions planned, in furtherance of the needs, goals, objectives and strategies of the Clayton County Consolidated Plan include: 1) Mitigate foreclosures and reduce homelessness; 2) Address the potential problems of lead-based paint hazards; 3) Work to reduce the incidence of poverty in Clayton County through increased private sector employment and through reducing housing cost burdens for low-income households; 4) Continuous evaluation and adjustments to the structure of service delivery to meet the needs of Clayton County's changing population; 5) Expanded focus on governmental coordination to ensure the most efficient investments of public resources; 6) Encouragement of participation of residents in the decision-making process of the local public housing authorities in Clayton County; 7) Cooperate with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in the planning and administration of its Continuum of Care Plan for the homeless; and 8) Addressing barriers to Fair Housing
